Tournament Hotel

The **Radisson Hotel** has been chosen as the host hotel this year. The Radisson is located right downtown of beautiful Saskatoon close to shopping, fine dining and entertainment. Check out the map enclosed in the package for excellent restaurants within walking distance, Galaxy movie theatre, tourist attractions within walking distance such as the popular Midtown Mall, one of Canada's most famous districts the Broadway Street just over the Broadway Bridge, and the River Park Promenade. The Radisson Hotel is located at 405 20th Street East. A special tournament rate of \$139.00 for a single or double room has been agreed upon plus all taxes (5% GST, 5% PST & 2% destination marketing fee), unlimited occupants. You may also upgrade to a King Room for \$159.00 + all taxes. Underground parking is available at the hotel at \$12.00 per day.

Rooms have been blocked until September 7, 2011. After that date all remaining rooms will be released for general sale at the regular price.

Transportation

Please see the map for driving directions to the hotel, as well as from the hotel to the training site. For those that choose to fly there is also a map showing the best route from the airport to the hotel. All major car rental agencies are available at the airport. There will also be free shuttle services provided by the host organization to the training site and back to the hotel on Saturday and Sunday afternoons for the competitions. A schedule of departure and return times will be posted at the registration table. For those that are driving there is free parking at SIAST.

Board of Directors' Meeting

The 1st IKD Canadian National AGM is scheduled for 3:00 pm on Friday in the Picasso Room.

Judges' Examination

The Judges' clinic, written exam and practical exam is scheduled for Friday evening. The clinic commences at 6:30 pm., followed by the practical exam at 8:00 pm, finishing with the written exam at 9:00 pm. All events will be held in the Michael Angelo Room with Sensei Woon-A-Tai. The clinic is open to all black belts at a rate of \$20.00. The black belts who are taking the exam the fee is \$80.00 which includes the clinic, and written and practical exams.

Kyu and Dan Examinations

This year being Saskatchewan's 30th anniversary, Sensei Woon-A-Tai has agreed to allow all kyu ranks in both the grading and the tournament. Kyu examinations are going to occur on Sunday at 10:00 am immediately after training for all kyu ranks in the Michael Angelo Room. The rate is \$40.00 per person and will include the IKD kyu certificate and the new belt. ***All instructors who will be having students grade for Kyu rank must submit the grading information form and include the student's belt color and size needed.***

Dan examinations will take place on Saturday at 10:00 am after the training in the Michael Angelo Room. For all Dan grading and registration fees please see the attached payment information sheet #6. A registration form and two passport photos should be available along with the appropriate registration fee. All participants must submit their own Dan grading form for conformation.

All those grading for either Kyu or Dan examinations must take the training clinics!

Training Clinics

Training this year will be on both Saturday and Sunday mornings at 9:00 am. There will be two simultaneous clinics at the hotel, one held in the Picasso room and one in the Michael Angelo Room. Further information as to who is training in which rooms depending on how many are in each group will be available on arrival. *The fee for the two days of training is \$30.00 per person.* All those grading for either Kyu or Dan rank must take the seminars.

Youth and Adult Competitions

All competitions will take place at the SIAST Gymnasium. There is a map in all registration packages for your convenience. Located near SIAST for your convenience is Tim Horton's, Subway, Pharmasave, Dairy Queen, Medical Centre, & a Cold Beer and Wine Store. This year being Saskatchewan's 30th anniversary, Sensei Woon-A-Tai has agreed to allow all kyu ranks in both the grading and the tournament. Transportation will be available for all competitors, judges, coaches and spectators. Travel schedule will be available at the registration table that weekend. *Youth and adult individual entry fee is \$30.00 per person and team events are \$45.00 per team.*

NEW:

This year the men's team kumite will be 3-person teams, and every province can have as many teams as they wish - in team kumite only.

Adult team kata and team kumite will be brown & black belt mixed

For adult team kata and kumite the ages will remain as previous years, 18 years and older

Youth have only team kata, no team kumite.

There will also be individual Senior kata & kumite events.

The Kyu tournament of both youth and adults to the finals, Youth Team Kata, the youth brown & black belt eliminations as well as team kumite eliminations will be held on Saturday from 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm. at the SIAST Gym. The Youth brown & black belt finals and the adult brown and black belt eliminations and finals as well as the adult team kata and team kumite finals will be held on Sunday from 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm.

The age category will be the same as previous years, ***however categories may change based on actual registration.***

This year we will be introducing Bunkai (application of Kata) and Enbu (demonstration). It will only be a demonstration event this year performed by the Ontario team and narrated by Sensei Woon-A-Tai, and will be part of the National competition commencing next year.
